Position Summary: Classroom floaters for Early Childhood and Head Start programs assist Lead Teachers in planning and implementing learning experiences that advance the intellectual, emotional, social, and physical development of children within a safe, healthy learning environment. They encourage the involvement of the families of the children of the program and support the development of relationships between children and their families.

Responsibilities:

- Working with children ages 6 weeks to 5 yrs. old.
- Learn and implement the Creative Curriculum and NAEYC Standards
- Plan developmentally appropriate lessons
- Work collaboratively with lead teacher
- Ensure the safety of all children
- Assess children on a regular basis
- Schedule & conduct parent/teacher conference
- Model appropriate behavior
- Use positive discipline
- Engage in professional development trainings, workshops and/or classes
- Complete all necessary documentation & maintain it up-to-date
- Implement family style eating
- Maintain positive attitude
- Ability to move between classrooms onsite
- Ability to move among the various sites when needed
- Having consistent, reliable personal transportation or the ability to use public transportation
- Ability to receive a work-related phone call assigning you to a different site and responding to it immediately
